


THE FOLD-AND-CUT BAT


It is possible to fold a piece of paper and cut out a bat with a single cut.


- 1. Fold a piece of A4 paper in half.
- 2. Fold a small triangle in a corner (on the crease edge from the first fold).
- 3. Turn the paper over.







- 4. Fold the dog-ear edge back about 1cm.
- 5. Fold the whole top-left corner down.
- 6. Turn the paper over






- 7. Fold the top-left corner down.
- 8. Fold the bottom-left corner behind the paper until it pokes out.
- 9. Cut through parallel to the edge so you clip that tiny triangle.
